

CCNE Introduces Accreditation Connection

This November, the Commission on Collegiate Nursing Education (CCNE) is launching Accreditation Connection—a new initiative providing program representatives with the opportunity to learn more about the CCNE accreditation standards and processes, engage with CCNE staff around hot topics and questions, and learn from peers.

What's the format?

Each regularly scheduled webinar will begin with a focus on a topic of interest related to CCNE accreditation. Participants are encouraged to come with questions related to that subject. An open Q&A will follow, and the webinar will wrap-up with networking time for participants to discuss the session's topic and other areas of interest.

Who's invited?

Program administrators and faculty involved in baccalaureate and graduate nursing education programs, entry-to-practice nurse residency programs, and nurse practitioner (NP) fellowship/residency programs. Each Accreditation Connection session will be specifically identified as intended for one or more of these three program types.

Does my program have to be CCNE-accredited to participate?

No! Accreditation Connection is open to representatives from accredited programs, new applicant programs, and programs just beginning their accreditation journey.

Is there a cost to participate?

Accreditation Connection is offered free of charge.
