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## BACKGROUND/INTRODUCTION

- To enhance teaching nursing skills while integrating the core competencies of the American Association of Colleges of Nursing (AACN, 2021) essentials, short video clips, aligned with nursing skills in the prelicensure baccalaureate program's curriculum were developed.
- The videos were designed to assist students in gaining a deeper understanding of common errors or events while performing nursing skills and how to navigate them utilizing clinical judgment, assessment, safety, and the essentials.

**CASE Moments™:**

- **C** = Clinical Judgment
- **A** = Assessment
  - (and/or correlation to the NCLEX–RN® test plan)
- **S** = Safety
- **E** = Essentials
  - (Social Determinants of Health, Spheres, Culture Sensitivity/Awareness, Domains)

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## PURPOSE/SIGNIFICANCE

- As patient acuity continues to rise and the demand for clinical judgment formation is critical, nursing education has an obligation to fulfill.
- CASE Moments™ were developed to accompany nursing skills and represent situations in nursing care that require the nurse to pause and consider factors that impact the patient and to make the best clinical decisions.
- Exposure to situations identified in each CASE Moment™, affords structured guidance and reflection in the moment, as well as formation of clinical judgment while integrating AACN essentials in support of a commitment to graduate practice ready nurses.

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## EXAMPLES OF DEVELOPED CASE MOMENTS™

- Irregular heart rate
- Delegation
- Patient cannot afford wound care supplies
- Patient requesting medications to be crushed that cannot be crushed
- Patient only takes ½ doses of medications to save money and purchase food
- Concerns of home safety/intermittent access to clean warm water at home
- Continuous suction during insertion & removal of suction catheter
- Patient does not speak English

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## PROCESSES/PROCEDURES



Pre-Licensure Nursing Skill Videos



A total of forty short CASE Moment™ video clips were developed and aligned with the ten nursing skills in the nursing program.

The videos were written and recorded in collaboration with faculty, students, and media over a period of three months, including peer review by faculty, staff, and leaders.

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## RECOMMENDATIONS

- TikTok and YouTube are becoming the preferred source of learning for many students.
- Nurse educators must identify innovative ways to engage and inspire today's students.
- The development and integration of short video clips to provide moments for reflection while learning nursing skills.
- Can be integrated into all learning environments and across the curriculum.



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## STRATEGIES FOR INTEGRATION

- Creativity = Integration
- Classroom & Clinical Learning:
  - Level each CASE Moments™ video to the course
  - Engage in Socratic Questioning to elicit clinical judgment
  - Play the video on mute
