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Journal Clubs

- Characteristics
 - Focus on a chosen article
 - Discuss summary of the study
 - Facilitate reflective discussions

- Benefits
 - Improve comprehension and critical evaluation
 - Reduces knowledgepractice gap
 - Fosters professional growth

- Student Barriers
 - Time constraints
 - Competing priorities
- · COVID-19



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Our Transition to Journal Club in Class

- Use research articles in every class
 - Apply course content
 - Align topics with other courses
- Exams
 - Article distributed day before
 - Exam items include questions that require application and critique





Results

- Initial exam average drop, followed by recovery to previous exam averages
- Allows for early intervention for at-risk students
- Positive course evaluations



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Student Feedback

Implications for Practice
